## Visitor Agreement

The visitation rules listed below follow guidance from state and federal agencies to allow indoor and outdoor visitation for our residents in a safe manner.

1. Screening of all who enter the facility for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., temperature checks, questions about and observations of signs or symptoms), and denial of entry of those with signs or symptoms regardless of vaccination status or those who are unvaccinated and have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 infection in the prior 14 days.
2. Visitors, to include children, will screen each time they enter the facility. The sticker from the screening kiosk must be always worn by ALL visitors while inside the facility. Visitors will also need to sign out when leaving the facility.
3. Visitors must follow infection control practices listed below at all times while in the facility or during an outside visit:
  - Perform hand hygiene with an alcohol-based hand rub, before and after visitation.
  - Wear a mask covering both the mouth and nose for the entire visit and for indoor visits, wear a facility-provided surgical mask covering both the mouth and nose. A face shield, N95 mask, gown and gloves may also be required if the resident is on isolation. NOTE: Exceptions may be made if all involved in the visit are fully vaccinated or for resident choice.
  - Children visitors must be able to wear a face covering or mask during the entire visits and remain with their guardian who will be responsible for assuring that all safety measures are followed.
  - Visitors must stay in the designated outdoor/indoor visit location and are not allowed to visit any other resident(s) or roam the hallways.
  - Social distancing of at least six feet must be maintained unless resident preferences or needs allow.
4. While not recommended, residents who are on transmission-based precautions (TBP) or quarantine can still receive visitors. In these cases, visits will occur in the resident's room and the resident will wear a well-fitting facemask (if tolerated). Please be advised that there is a higher risk of COVID and by visiting you are assuming that risk. Please wear full PPE at all times during your visit, remain socially distanced at least 6 feet from the resident, and maintain hand hygiene. Do not visit if you have symptoms of COVID-19 and if symptoms develop, please inform the facility.
5. Visitors are to always remain in the designated visiting space during the visit. If assistance is needed, staff should be alerted by using the call bell or by calling the facility main number if visiting outdoors. Please do not approach the nurse's station.
6. Any visitor who develops a diagnosis of COVID-19 or signs and symptoms within 14 days of visiting a resident must immediately notify the facility administrator of the date they were visiting and the resident they were in contact with.

I have read the above visitation requirements and agree to comply with all regardless of my past COVID-19 status and/or vaccination status. I understand that if I do not comply, I will be asked to leave and may not be permitted to visit in the future, except for compassionate care situations (e.g., end of life). Facilities have discretion to alter visitation practices based on disease transmission in the facility or community, visitor non-compliance, or other factors.
